Prayer is a love response to the two great commandments. Both the one who prays and the one prayed for are transformed. Human Poverty and Oppression
Promoting War; Terrorism; Mass Murder;
The Occult; and Satanic Activities;
Loneliness and Depression
Pride, Anger, Greed and Lust
Fear and Unforgiveness
